Effective Date: October 15, 2024

1. License Grant

enerbrill, the developer and owner of BrillTree Application, grants you a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable license to use the software in accordance with this agreement. The software is licensed, not sold, and remains the property of BrillTree.

2. Offline Usage and Data Privacy

BrillTree is provided as an executable file that functions **independently of an internet connection** once downloaded and installed on your machine. As such, the software does not collect or transmit any personal or sensitive data from your device during its use.

The only information collected by **enerbrill** is non-personal machine-specific data (e.g., MAC address, hostname, CPU serial number) for the purpose of verifying your license. This data is stored locally and is not accessible to BrillTree or any third parties during normal operation of the software.

3. Payment and Refund Policy

All payments for the software are **non-refundable**. The software is sold "**as-is**", and the developer is not responsible for any malfunctions or incompatibilities that arise after the purchase. Updates and bug fixes will be provided as long as the app is installed on the original machine where it was downloaded.

4. Updates and Upgrades

- **Minor Updates:** Users who have purchased BrillTree will receive free bug fixes and updates, provided the software remains installed on the original machine.
- **Major Upgrades:** Major upgrades will be offered to existing users at a **discounted price**.
